A Children's Literacy Program

Research shows that a child's reading level at the end of Grade Three is a more accurate predictor of school success than any other variable.

Through one-to-one tutoring, we provide a supportive environment that builds children's self-confidence and literacy skills.

The Program

- students are in grades one to four
- 30 minutes per session, one tutor to one student
- trained volunteer tutors provide a supportive learning environment, helping to improve reading fluency, comprehension, and self-confidence when reading

Volunteers

- parents and/or community volunteers
- screening done through application forms and criminal record checks
- commit to tutoring for 1.5 hours a week for 15-17 weeks
- must attend a 3 hour training session before tutoring begins
